HELPING YOU ACHIEVE

Endorsement courses offer a cost effective and easily accessible way to increase your teaching skills.

Teachers have multiple opportunities to participate in endorsement courses through SEDC. Courses range from one night a week where attendance is required to completely on-line classes that can be accessed and completed on your own schedule.

MATH ENDORSEMENT- SEDC is sponsoring an Elementary Math Endorsement program. The final course in the series: EDEL 5550 will be offered in Fall 2018. Another series is planned to begin in January 2019 with EDEL 5500.

READING ENDORSEMENT- SEDC partners with another RSC to provide ongoing classes for the Reading Level 1 Endorsement.

EDTECH ENDORSEMENT- SEDC partners with UEN and SUU to offer



courses leading to an Educational Technology Endorsement. Classes begin throughout the fall and are primarily on-line.

STEM ENDORSEMENT- SEDC works closely with faculty and staff at SUU to provide a Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math Endorsement program. This endorsement is completed by cohorts and a new cohort is planned to begin in 2019.

Tuition for most of these endorsements typically range from \$200 to \$300 per 3 credit course (Credit for the ETEP is less than \$25 per credit). The Endorsements range from 18 to 21 credit hours. Contact SEDC for more information about any of these endorsement programs.
