The Community Mapping Program involves teachers and students in a community-based project that incorporates geo-spatial technology and other characteristics of active and inquiry-based curriculum. Students use GIS (Geographic Information Systems) & GPS in the process of discovering and answering questions about their community, rather than learning technology for technology's sake. The five day Community Mapping Workshop models active classroom and fieldwork with community partners as participants design a classroom project.
